How you are wired...

Leader

You will need to process e-mails, texts, phone calls, meetings, and information in a timely manner.

Energetic

You will need to provide energy both on and off the platform. Having a good “stage presence” is necessary, as is an active “leadership presence” within teams.

Communicate

You will need to share your vision and set expectations with leaders, volunteers, and staff.

Christ Follower

You must have a love for Christ and a desire to continue taking Next Steps in your relationship with Him

TVC Lover

You must be fully on board with TVC's mission of connecting people with God, support our values of Serve and Connect, and be comfortable with the idea of being a serving church for unchurched people

What you will do...

1. Oversee the Wednesday evening Fusion service
2. Create relationships with community organizations for recruiting youth
3. Create a promotion plan in conjunction with Communications Director
4. Help with leadership development
5. Recruit leaders and volunteers
6. Have an apprentice and help them to grow in their ability to lead in ministry
7. Work alongside the other TVC Fusion Leaders (from other campuses and Central Support) to plan and run the Summer and Winter camps and retreats
8. Participate in the life of the Middleville campus and surrounding community, including outreach, special events, and volunteering, etc.

What success looks like...

1. Middleville youth are attending Fusion weekly services and Winter/Summer Retreats and Camps.
2. As a result, youth are forming lasting connections with God and others.
3. Fusion youth leaders are growing both spiritually and in their leadership ability.
